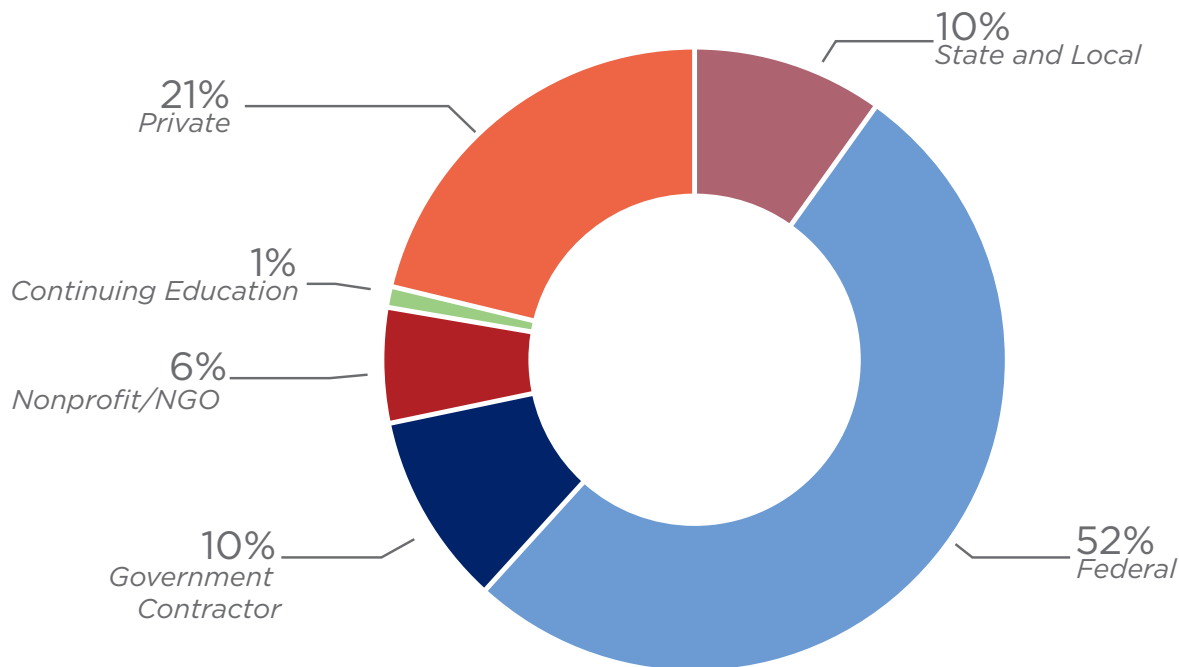


# CLASS OF 2017 EMPLOYERS

## MASTER OF INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS



•Class of 2017 Bush School graduates were asked to complete a survey to indicate employment and/or enrollment in continuing education. The survey was conducted by the Office of Career & Student Services from graduation in May 2017 to November 2017 (six-months post-graduation) based on professional standards set by the Association of Professional Schools of International Affairs (APSIA) for graduate programs in international affairs across the world.

•Percentages are based on the 94% of graduates (77 of 82 job-seeking graduates) who responded to the survey. Of those responding to our survey, 81% (62 of 77 respondents) were employed within six months of graduation.
