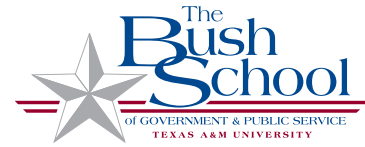

### SCHOLARSHIPS

- Students with sponsoring agencies are eligible to receive matching scholarships from the Bush School of up to \$500 per course.
- Scholarship funds are applied towards the tuition and fees for courses offered at the United Way facility in Houston, as part of the graduate Certificate in Nonprofit Management.

### CURRICULUM

- Students complete 12 credit hours of graduate-level coursework. There are two required courses:
  - Foundations of the Nonprofit Sector (3 credit hours)
  - Management and Leadership of Nonprofit Organizations (3 credit hours).
- Students select two elective graduate courses (6 credit hours) from a variety of options.
- Courses are available online, or in residence at the College Station campus or the United Way Center in Houston.
- Students receive graduate transcript credit from Texas A&M University for the coursework.

### ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

Candidates must have an undergraduate degree from an accredited university. Professional experience in the field of nonprofit management is recommended.

### ADMISSION

To apply for enrollment in the Certificate in Nonprofit Management Houston program, candidates should submit the following items to the Bush School's office of extended education.

- Certificate Program Application Form
- Texas Common Application
- Official transcripts from all universities attended
- Statement of purpose
- Resume
