

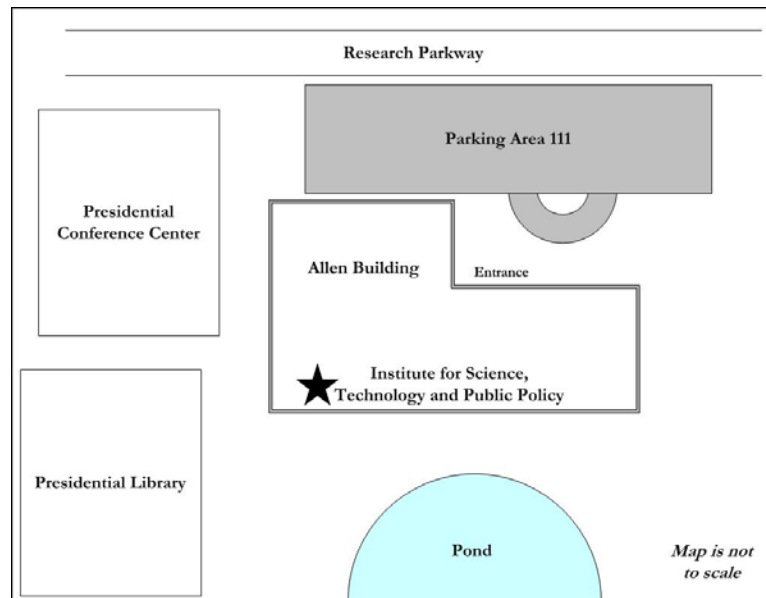
Visit the Institute for Science, Technology and Public Policy

If you are visiting the Texas A&M University campus, the Institute is located in the Robert H. and Judy Ley Allen Building, next to the George Bush Presidential Library and Conference Center on the University's west campus. ISTPP offices are located on the first floor, in the southeast corner of the Allen Building, the portion closest to the Presidential Library.

Thirty-minute visitor parking is available in Parking Area 111. Facing the building, you will see a blue canopy over the main entrance, to your right. Go to this entrance, through the sliding glass doors, and enter the atrium of the Allen Building. Turn left from the atrium and proceed to the glass doors at the far end (you will pass a bust of former president George H.W. Bush). These doors are the entrance to the Institute's suite of offices. Welcome to the Institute for Science, Technology and Public Policy!



Driving Directions – From the North, South or East

- Take Highway 6 to College Station
- Take the University Drive exit and cross the overpass
- Follow University Drive past the Texas A&M University main campus until you reach Research Parkway (about 3.8 miles)
- Turn left onto Research Parkway
- Follow Research Parkway until you reach Parking Area 111, which is in front of the Bush School/Allen Building

From the West

- Take Highway 21 until you reach Highway 47 on the outskirts of Bryan (exit right)
- Take Highway 47 to FM 60 and turn left onto FM 60
- Take FM 60 until you cross over the FM 2818 overpass
- After the overpass, take the first right onto Research Parkway
- Follow Research Parkway until you reach Parking Area 111, which is in front of the Bush School/Allen Building
