

Tenure-Track, Assistant Professor in National Security & Diplomacy

Bush School faculty exclusively teach master's degree graduate students in international affairs in a standard 2-2 load. The successful candidate will be expected to teach at least one section of the required course in introductory-level empirical methods.
