



•Class of 2018 Bush School graduates were asked to complete a survey to indicate employment and/or enrollment in continuing education. The survey was conducted by the Office of Career & Student Services from graduation in May 2018 to November 2018 (six-months post-graduation) based on professional standards set by the Network of Schools of Public Policy, Affairs, and Administration (NASPAA), representing graduate programs in public administration and public policy across the country.

•Percentages are based on the 87% of graduates (68 of 78 job-seeking graduates) who responded to the survey. Of those responding to our survey, 96% (65 of 68 respondents) were employed within six months of graduating.
