
CLASS OF 2019 EMPLOYERS MASTER OF PUBLIC SERVICE & ADMINISTRATION





•Class of 2019 Bush School graduates were asked to complete a survey to indicate employment and/or enrollment in continuing education. The survey was conducted by the Office of Career & Student Services from graduation in May 2019 to November 2019 (six-months post-graduation) based on professional standards set by the Network of Schools of Public Policy, Affairs, and Administration (NASPAA), representing graduate programs in public administration and public policy across the country.

•Percentages are based on the 88% of graduates (78 of 83 job-seeking graduates) who responded to the survey. Of those responding to our survey, 89% (65 of 73 respondents) were employed within six months of graduating.
