

ONLINE EXECUTIVE MASTER OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND **ADMINISTRATION (EMPSA)**

The Executive Master of Public Service and Administration (EMPSA) program prepares principled leaders who have the critical skills, knowledge, and expertise to excel and lead in the public service field, specifically in homeland security, nonprofit management, or public management. The program is delivered online in order to serve full-time working executives and professionals. Admitted students must select a track of Homeland Security, Nonprofit Management, or Public Management.

- Pursue your education through rigorous online
- Attend two, one-week residency requirements in College Station, Texas.
- Earn a 39-graduate-credit-hour degree from Texas A&M University.
- Collaborate with industry and governmental partners in a capstone project.
- Complete the degree in approximately two to three years depending on transfer credits and your schedule.




