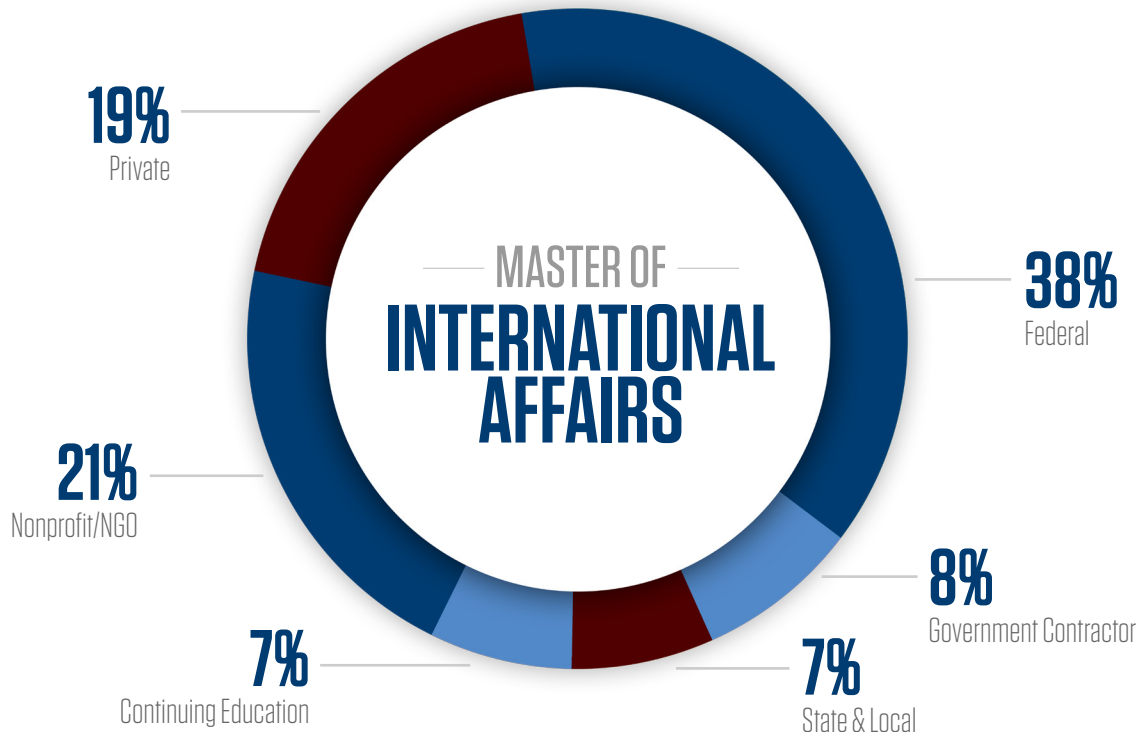

- Class of 2021 Bush School graduates were asked to complete a survey to indicate employment and/or enrollment in continuing education. The survey was conducted by the Office of Career & Student Services from graduation in May 2021 to November 2021 (six-months post-graduation) based on professional standards set by the Association of Professional Schools of International Affairs (APSIA) for graduate programs in international affairs across the world.
- Percentages are based on the 84% of graduates (68 of 81 job-seeking graduates) who responded to the survey. Of those responding to our survey, 90% (61 of 68 respondents) were employed or continuing their education within six months of graduation.
