	GRE/GMAT: Upload to SOPHAS and/or the Supplemental MIA Application, if required or desired. Scores may not be required for the MPH portion, but for the MIA portion, scores are:  • Required for those with a cumulative GPA below a 3.2. We do not round up! (A 3.18 is below 3.2.)  • Optional for those with a cumulative GPA of a 3.2 or above.  • Encouraged for applicants who feel their scores can complement a strong file or offset concerns.
