All applicants to the 3+2 MIA/INTS degree program must complete the following degree planning sheet with their INTS advisor and upload to their 3+2 application to ensure the applicant:

- ✓ is classified as a U3 (or junior) at the time of their application to the 3+2 program, *and*
- ✓ has worked with their UG advisor to map out undergrad courses the student must complete prior to and after entry into the 3+2 program (if admitted), *and*
- ✓ has (or will have) 66-78 credit hours of their undergrad degree completed by the start of the fall 2022 semester, *and*
- ✓ is on track to satisfy all of the pre-requisite course requirements (102+ hours) by the start of the fall 2023 semester, *and*
- ✓ is in the International Politics and Diplomacy track of the INTS UG degree
- ✓ has (or can feasibly have) a cumulative GPA of a 3.5 or above by the fall 2023 semester, *and*
- ✓ has (or will have) completed their required study abroad trip prior to the start of the fall 2023 semester, *and*
- ✓ is in good academic standing with their undergrad department, *and*
- ✓ *is not expected to graduate or complete their undergrad degree in 2022 or 2023, and*
- ✓ ***understands that failure to satisfy ALL of these requirements prior to the fall 2023 semester will result in being removed from the 3+2 program (if admission was offered).***

An application will NOT be accepted without a completed degree planning sheet.
