Information on PhD Program in Political Science

- Nationally and internationally recognized PhD program in political science. Our department is
 ranked number 13 in the world according to the 2021 Global ShanghaiRanking: https://www.

- Our faculty frequently coauthor with graduate students. This has resulted in peer-reviewed publications in our field's top journals, including the *American Political Science Review, American Journal of Political Science*, and *Journal of Politics*.
- We provide full funding to all PhD students admitted into our program. Most students we admit work for 20 hours per week as a teaching assistant or research assistant in years 1-4 and receive a stipend for this work. In their fifth year, students teach their own classes as an instructor of record. We cover tuition and fees for all of our students. We guarantee funding for five years.
- We are a five-year PhD program. This includes three years of coursework and two years of dissertation writing.
- Our typical cohort size is 6-12 students.
- We feature small PhD seminars, typically ranging between 5-10 students.
- Our students learn state of the art quantitative research methods (including statistical research methods and game theory) and gain substantive knowledge in their fields of study.
- We provide funding to all of our graduate students to present their research at at least one professional conference per year.
- Recent PhD graduates have accepted tenure-track positions at: American University, Georgia State University, Indiana University, Mississippi State University, Kansas University, University College Dublin, University of Colorado, University of Georgia, University of Iowa and University of Missouri.
