Students may apply and be eligible for financial aid and scholarships. With the exception of PSAA 601, PSAA 675, and PSAA 676, all Texas A&M University graduate students may take these courses. However, if students want to earn a certificate, they must apply and be accepted into the certificate program prior to taking courses and earn at least a 3.0 GPA. If students want to earn an Executive Master of Public Service and

Administration (EMPSA), they must apply and be accepted into EMPSA.
