

Class of 2024 Bush School graduates were asked to complete a survey to indicate employment and/or enrollment in continuing education. The survey was conducted by the Office of Career & Student Services from graduation in May 2024 to November 2024 (six-months post-graduation) based on professional standards set by the Association of Professional Schools of International Affairs (APSIA) for graduate programs in international affairs across the world.

Percentages are based on the 72% of graduates (61 of 85 job-seeking graduates) who responded to the survey. Of those responding to our survey, 97% (59 of 61 respondents) were employed or continuing their education within six months of graduating.
